**Tournament Notes**

- Santa Clara is off to Fairfield for the 2026 WCC Championship, once again held at the par 72, Green Valley Country Club.
- SCU finished third in last season's event with a three-day total of 24-over 888. Chloe Lam had the top individual finish, tying for fifth at 3-over 219, as a freshman.
- This year's event has expanded from six to eight teams: Santa Clara, Augusta University, Gonzaga, Pepperdine, San Francisco, Washington State, Oregon State and Seattle U.
- Kelsey Kim will tee off No. 1 followed by Lam, Audrey Brust, Alexa Pineda and Rachael Wang. Proud Sriwongngam will be the Broncos' substitute if needed.
- The Broncos are looking for their first-ever WCC Championship title. They have finished third on multiple occasions, including three of the last four seasons.

**Season Notes**

- Santa Clara has finished in the top five of six of the nine events played, including five top-three finishes and one victory.
- The Broncos are currently shattering the program record for team scoring average. They currently hold a 291.19 average - well ahead of the current record set in 2024-25 of 295.67 strokes.
- Three players - Kelsey Kim, Audrey Brust and Chloe Lam - currently boast scoring averages that rank top-five in a single season in program history.
- Kim's average of 71.59 strokes is on pace to be the program's lowest scoring average in history. She has already set the single-season program record for rounds under par (14), and is tied for second and third, respectively, in top-20 and top-10 finishes with eight and seven, respectively.
- Kim has five finishes on the season that all rank inside the top-10 lowest in program history. She shot a career-low 6-under 210 at the San Diego State Classic to finish runner-up, which is tied for the fourth-lowest score in history. She had a pair of 5-under 211s at the Rainbow Wahine Invitational and Golf Iconic Classic, as well as a pair of 4-under 212s at the Kalispel Invitational and Wyoming Cowgirl Classic. Those scores are tied for the sixth and ninth lowest in program history, respectively.
- Santa Clara could not have asked for a much better fall campaign. The Broncos won the first event of the season, the Kalispel Invitational, and shot under par in the next three tournaments to finish second, fourth and tied for second.
- Entering this season, Santa Clara had only shot under par as a team twice in program history. They more than doubled that amount in the fall alone with three consecutive such performances.
- The Broncos opened the season by winning the Kalispel Invitational by 10 strokes for the 19th team title under head coach Krystal Kelly.
- SCU shot the second-lowest final score to par in program history at the Rainbow Wahine Invitational, finishing 4-under 860.
- Brust's scoring average of 73.44 strokes is currently the third-lowest in school history. The senior has quietly put together an outstanding year of her own with six rounds under par, five top-20 and three top-10 finishes. She tied her own program record for the lowest individual round of 5-under par with a 67 in the second round of the Rainbow Wahine Invitational. She would go on to finish the event 3-under 213.
- Lam has the fourth-lowest scoring average in program history at 73.56 strokes, and has five top-20 finishes of her own with her best being a tie for third at the Juli Inkster Tournament (1-over 217).
- The Broncos were picked third in the WCC Preseason Coaches Poll while Kim was tabbed Preseason All-WCC.

## Career Notes

- In addition to boasting the program's lowest season scoring average, Kim is also on pace to hold the lowest career scoring average. She is averaging 73.55 strokes over 89 career rounds.
- Although just a junior, Kim already has surpassed the program record for career rounds under par previously held by Annie Freman (18). She has 23 such rounds and counting.
- Kim is also climbing up the list for both career top-10 and top-20 finishes. She is tied for fifth (with Audrey Brust) for top-10 finishes (9) and is tied for sixth in top-20 finishes with 19.
- Brust has a career scoring average of 74.89 strokes - currently the fourth-best in program history. She is set to have sole possession of the most rounds played in school history as she enters the WCC Championship tied with Freman at the top of the list with 123.
- Brust has 22 career top-20 finishes, good for fourth-most in program history. Her nine top-10 finishes are tied with Kim for fifth. She also has 17 career rounds under par, just one shy of tying Freman for second-most.
- Only a sophomore, Chloe Lam has also made an impact on the record book. Her 73.96 scoring average ranks right behind Kim on the all-time list (minimum 50 rounds played), and her nine rounds under par are tied for the eighth-most in program history.
- Head Coach Krystal Kelly is looking for her 20th win as the Broncos' head coach.
