## AGAINST THE DUKES

Saturday's game marks the fourth-ever meeting between Stonehill and Duquesne, with the Skyhawks owning a 2-1 advantage. Stonehill won the first contest, 24-20, in 2022 at W.B. Mason Stadium, and the Skyhawks claimed the rematch in 2023, 33-28, at Rooney Field. Last fall, the Dukes emerged with a 48-34 victory in Easton, Mass. The home teams in this series are 1-2.

## LAST TIME OUT

In the 10-3 victory in the NEC opener against LIU last week, **CHARLES BATTAGLIA** recorded 2.0 sacks and tied **CHRISTOPHER WILLIAMS** for the team lead with nine tackles. For his effort, Battaglia was selected as the NEC/Atlantic Tomorrow's Office Defensive Player of the Week. Stonehill's three points surrendered marked the fewest the Skyhawks have surrendered to a Division I opponent and the fewest overall since a 76-0 win over Post University in 2022. **SIDOINE DJIMBOU** and **SPENCER DAVILA** both intercepted passes for the Skyhawks. **JACK O'CONNELL** found **ZACHARY KIM** for a 12-yard touchdown strike in the fourth quarter to put Stonehill on top for good. **LOGAN CHENETTE** had three punts for a 48.3-yard average, including a game-high 60-yarder.

## AMONG THE NATION'S BEST

Through five games, Stonehill has achieved some of the best team and individual results in the nation in the FCS. The Skyhawks rank sixth in red-zone defense (.667), eighth in completion percentage (.703), 11th in kick-off returns (27.9), 12th in fumbles lost (one), 13th in passing yards allowed (147.8), 13th in scoring defense (18.2), 13th in defensive touchdowns (one) and 18th in fourth-down conversion percentage defense (.364).

Individually, **RICHARD MOSLEY III** is second in fumbles recovered (two), **JACK O'CONNELL** stands ninth in completion percentage (.703) and 11th in completions per game (20.4). **TORANCE WASHINGTON, JR.** ranks sixth in kick return average (32.3), while **ZACHARY KIM** is 11th in receiving touchdowns (four).

## GAME WINNER

With the team's back against the wall, Stonehill converted a 4th and 21 with 1:45 left to play in the fourth quarter on a 34-yard TD pass from **JACK O'CONNELL** to **BRIGHAM DUNPHY**, helping the Skyhawks to a 13-10 win at Maine Sept. 13. The victory was the first ever for Stonehill over a CAA opponent.

## I'LL TAKE THAT

Against Maine Sept. 13, **RICHARD MOSLEY III** recovered a fumble, giving him that version of a takeaway for two-straight games (Lafayette, Sept. 6).

## SPORTSCENTER NO. 4

In the fourth quarter against Lafayette on Sept. 6, **ANTHONY BUSA** made an acrobatic one-handed interception against the Leopards. The highlight reel play was selected as the No. 4 play on ESPN's Sportscenter on Sept. 7.

## HIGH MARKS

**RICHARD MOSLEY III's** 90-yard fumble return for a touchdown against Lafayette marked the first Stonehill scoop for a score of more than 70 yards since Jared Gaines had a 72-yard return for a TD at Assumption in 2009.

## DEFENSIVE START

Stonehill allowed only 12 points and 288 yards of total offense in its season opener at Sacred Heart Aug. 30. This marked the fewest points allowed by the Skyhawks since a 50-10 victory over Wagner on Nov. 5, 2022. The 12 points surrendered was the fewest allowed on the road by Stonehill since a 42-6 win at Southern Connecticut State on Nov. 13, 2021.

## 2025 NOTES

It was also the best defensive showing in a season opener on the road for the Skyhawks since a 27-10 win at Bloomsburg on Sept. 5, 2015.

The Skyhawks held Maine to 10 points and only 266 yards of total offense, including just 95 passing yards, on Sept. 13.

Stonehill followed up those performances by only allowing three points and 241 yards of total offense in the 10-3 win over LIU Sept. 27. The three points was the fewest ever allowed to a Division I opponent and the fewest overall since a 76-0 win over Post University on Sept. 10, 2022.

### MOVING' ON UP!

**ELI GARDNER**, The Paul Finn '71 Head Football Coach, (39-47) took sole possession of second place in the program's varsity era (1988-pres.) with his 37th career win against Sacred Heart last fall. He moved past **CONNIE DRISCOLL** who posted a 36-24 mark at the College from 1993 to 1998, and now trails just **ROBERT TALLEY** with 48 wins (48-46) from 2007-2015. Gardner's 10 years as head coach surpasses Talley as the longest tenured head coach in the program's varsity era.

### NEXT LEVEL

Stonehill College announced in early April, 2022, that it had accepted an invitation to join the NCAA Division I Northeast Conference (NE7)C, beginning a four-year Division I transition period to conclude in 2026. Earlier this year, the NCAA announced that Stonehill had completed its accelerated reclassification to full NCAA Division I status, effective for the 2025-26 athletic season, and are now eligible for NCAA tournament participation. The Skyhawks entire set of 23 varsity programs now compete in the NEC, with the exception of equestrian, women's ice hockey (NEWHA) and men's ice hockey (independent).

### NICE TO MEET YOU

Stonehill will take on four opponents this season for the first time in program history. CAA conference member Maine will have its first ever matchup with the Skyhawks on Sept. 13 in Orono, Maine. On the following week, Stonehill will face the first of two Ivy League opponents when it hosts Penn on Saturday, Sept. 20 in Easton. In October, Yale, also of the Ivy League, will welcome the Skyhawks for that first matchup on Saturday, Oct. 18 in New Haven, Conn. Finally, Stonehill will face Mercyhurst in Erie, Pa., for that inaugural contest on Saturday, Oct. 25.

### HALFWAY THERE

Stonehill is 27-4 under head coach **ELI GARDNER** when holding a halftime lead. The Skyhawks are 30-4 under Gardner when leading after three quarters.

In June, **ELI GARDNER**, The Paul Finn '71 Head Football Coach named seniors **FAISAL MASS** and **BRIGHAM DUNPHY** as team captains.

In addition to Mass and Dunphy, coach Gardner chooses a game captain each week. **JAREL WASHINGTON** (Sacred Heart), **ZACK ATHY** (Lafayette), **TYLER BANNON** (Maine), **JACK O'CONNELL** (Maine) and **NICK TINKHAM** (LIU) were selected for the Skyhawks this season.

### PAUL FINN '71 HEAD FOOTBALL COACH

A meaningful chapter in Stonehill history was written on Saturday, September 20, as the College officially established the Paul Finn '71 Head Football Coach Endowment Fund. This fund creates a newly named coaching position, serving as an enduring tribute to the football program Finn helped form in 1970. It also marks the first-ever endowed role within Stonehill Athletics.

A founding member of Stonehill's club football team, the Knights—which paved the way for football to become a varsity sport in 1988—Finn has remained a dedicated supporter of the program since his time on the field. His longstanding commitment has paralleled the team's growth over the decades, culminating in its 2022 transition to NCAA Division I as a member of the Northeast Conference (NEC).

Prior to the football game against the University of Pennsylvania on September 20, the Skyhawks hosted an event to announce the creation of the Paul Finn Head Coach position. The honor was bestowed upon current Head Coach Eli Gardner, recognizing his energy, vision and commitment to student-athlete development.

Director of Athletics Dean O'Keefe '94 emphasized the long-term significance of Finn's support and philanthropy. "This game-changing gift will have a transformative effect on our Skyhawk football program and recognizes the vital role our coaches play in shaping student-athletes," he said. "We're deeply grateful to Paul for his enduring support and commitment."

An attorney and former Stonehill trustee, Finn began his legal career as a partner at Berks & Finn. He served there from 1978 to 1992 before becoming president of Commonwealth Mediation & Conciliation Inc., where he has since mediated thousands of claims and played a key role in managing high-profile cases. Finn is affiliated with several legal and mediation organizations and authors the Massachusetts Practice Series, Volume 47, Mediation & Arbitration. He was also recognized as one of the Lawyers of the Year by Massachusetts Lawyers Weekly. In addition to a bachelor's degree in history from Stonehill, Finn earned a master's degree in government administration from Harvard University Extension School and a Juris Doctor from New England School of Law.

In 2017, Finn delivered the acceptance speech when Stonehill inducted the 1970 Knights into the College's Athletic Hall of Fame.

### PRESEASON NOODS

Senior defensive back **MO SEIDE** (Malden, Mass.) was tabbed to the All-NEC preseason team. Seide was an All-NEC second-team selection and an All-New England team honoree last fall after leading the conference with four interceptions and ranking seventh in the league with eight passes defended.

In addition, Seide, along with senior defensive lineman **FAISAL MASS**, (Taunton, Mass.) junior linebacker **CHARLES BATTAGLIA** (Massapequa,

N.Y.) and junior offensive lineman **JOSHUA TROIANO** (Seekonk, Mass.) garnered nods to the Phil Steele Preseason All-NEC Team. Seide and Battaglia were named to the first team, while Mass and Troiano were selected to the second team. Mass ranked ninth on the team and second among defensive lineman with 35 tackles in 2024. Battaglia, a Jerry Rice Award finalist last year, was second on the team with 70 tackles, leading all NEC rookies, and was tabbed a FCS Freshman All-American. Troiano appeared in seven games a year ago.

## PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS

Stonehill was picked eighth in the pre-season coaches' poll the Conference announced at its Social Media Day on Aug. 4. The coaches poll is led by reigning NEC Champions and NCAA I FCS Championship participant Central Connecticut State with five of seven first place votes. Duquesne is second with two first-place votes, while Robert Morris (one first-place vote) was tied with LIU for third place. Rounding out the poll were Wagner (fifth), Saint Francis (sixth), Mercyhurst (seventh) and the Skyhawks, respectively.

## OTHER FIRSTS

In 2025, Stonehill will be eligible for the FCS postseason for the first-time in program history. It will also mark the first time that the Skyhawks will have a 12-game schedule, with five home contests and seven matchups on the road. Saturday's game against Sacred Heart also is the first time Stonehill has played a game in the month of August.

## WINNING FORMULAS

Stonehill was dealt just its fourth loss under **ELI GARDNER**, The Paul Finn '71 Head Football Coach, when scoring 30-plus points with its 48-34 setback to NEC-leading Duquesne last fall. The Skyhawks are 26-4 in Gardner's 10 years as head coach when surpassing 30 points. The Skyhawks are also a perfect 6-0 when rushing for 300-plus yards, including a 20-3 clip when rushing for 200-plus since Gardner took over as head coach. Stonehill is 19-4 all-time under coach Gardner when accumulating 400-plus yards of total offense.

## FOR OPENERS

Stonehill is 15-23 all-time in week one games in program history and have won three of its last six opening contests. The Skyhawks are 9-13 all-time in week one games on the road, having won three of its last five road openers. Under **ELI GARDNER**, The Paul Finn '71 Head Football Coach, Stonehill owns a 4-5 record in week one contests.

## TWIN 100S

Senior **JAREL WASHINGTON** (White Plains, N.Y.) and junior **ZAVION WOODARD** (Baltimore, Md.) both surpassed 100 yards in Stonehill's win over Sacred Heart on Sept. 21, 2024, marking the first time Stonehill has featured two running backs reaching the century mark in its NCAA I FCS era and first time overall since All-American Justin Felder (177) and Brian Kearns, Jr. (103) accomplished the feat in a 35-13 win over Bloomsburg (Pa.) Uni-

## We Are "Stonehill"

Stonehill is one word and pronounced STONE-hill, with the emphasis on the first syllable.

### SUCCESS IN THE CLASSROOM

Twenty-two Stonehill football players earned spots in last year's Fall 2024 NEC Honor Roll. Sophomore defensive back **PHOENIX SWARD** (Wakefield, R.I.) joined graduate **MICHAEL STRACHAN, JR.**, (Attleboro, Mass.) as two of the five Stonehill student-athletes across all fall sports to achieve a perfect 4.0 grade-point average. To qualify for the NEC Academic Honor Roll, student-athletes must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.20. Additionally, student-athletes who achieved a GPA of 3.75 or higher, earned a spot on the NEC Fall Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll.

### CHI ALPHA SIGMA

In April, the Stonehill college athletics department welcomed the classes of 2025 and 2026 for the institution's inaugural induction to the Chi Alpha Sigma Honor Society. Football graduate **MARCELLO BAINE** (Boston, Mass.) and **MICHAEL STRACHAN, JR.**, (Attleboro, Mass.) were class of 2025 inductees, while returning running back **MARCUS CRAWFORD** (Springfield, Mass.), offensive lineman **CONNOR IVEY** (Newtown, Conn.) and tight end **CODY RUFF** (Saco, Maine) were class of 2026 inductees. To be inducted into Chi Alpha Sigma, a student-athlete must be a member of a varsity athletics team at a four-year, accredited college or university that is a member of the NCAA or NAIA. They must also have achieved junior academic standing or higher after their fourth full-time semester and maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5.

### DIG

The Stonehill captains select a teammate to carry a team shovel to each practice and game over the course of the week. The Ames Shovel symbolizes the team's motto DIG - Discipline, Intellect and Grit. The shovel was chosen from the Ames shovel collection at Stonehill. The land that now holds the College was purchased by the Congregation of Holy Cross from the Ames Family that operated a world-class shovel factory known for their quality that helped supply many of America's major construction events. Known as the founder of the Ames Shovel Company, Oliver Ames was the youngest child of Captain John Ames and his wife Susanna Howard of West Bridgewater, Massachusetts. John Ames was the village blacksmith and made shovels in addition to a wide variety of other iron products. Oliver married Susanna Angier in 1803, and that same year moved to Easton where he bought a defunct nail making shop and began the production of shovels. In 1807, Oliver and his family moved to Plymouth where he supervised the shovel making plant of the Plymouth Iron Works. Shovel Production continued at his own North Easton factory. The Ames brand became known for its quality and the company became the key supplier to America's major construction events. Stonehill is home to the Ames Shovel Museum.

### 20-20 VISION

Stonehill is 32-18 overall in eight seasons under head coach Eli Gardner when scoring 20-plus points and 26-4 when scoring 30-plus points.

### CENTURY CHARM

Stonehill is 27-6 during head coach Eli Gardner's eight-year tenure at the helm when having a 100-yard rusher.

### OUR HOME

W.B. Mason Stadium is home to Stonehill field hockey, football, lacrosse, and track & field, and is one of the premier athletic facilities in the northeast.

Formally dedicated on September 10, 2005, the 2,400-seat stadium features a FieldTurf playing surface, a 400-meter eight-lane track, specialty areas for track and field events, and lighting for evening events. The playing field, Timothy J. Coughlin Memorial Field, was named in memory of Tim "Cogs" Coughlin, a football student-athlete and member of the Stonehill Class of 1980, who was managing director of Cantor Fitzgerald Securities and eSpeed when he lost his life in the attacks on the World Trade Center on September 11, 2001.

W.B. Mason president and CEO Leo Meehan, a Stonehill trustee and alumnus, announced prior to development of the facility that the company and its alumni employees would contribute \$1.5 million of the \$4 million cost of the project.

W.B. Mason Stadium has hosted nationally televised football games, as well as served as host to NCAA Championship events in field hockey and lacrosse as well as conference and New England Championships in track & field as well as field hockey and lacrosse.

The Skyhawks will enjoy a bye week before heading to New Haven, Conn., to take on Ivy League opponent Yale for the first meeting between the schools on Saturday, Oct. 18 at 12 p.m. at the Yale Bowl.

# THE PAUL FINN '71 HEAD FOOTBALL COACH



## HEAD COACH ELI GARDNER

Eli Gardner is in his 10th year as The Paul Finn '71 Head Football Coach at Stonehill, having been promoted after serving seven seasons on former head coach Robert Talley's coaching staff.

Gardner, the 2019 D2Football.com Northeast-10 Coach of the Year and Gridiron Club of Greater Boston's 2015 Division II Assistant Coach of the Year, steered the football program to a 39-

47 (.453) record as a head coach, including an 8-2 mark in 2021.

Gardner has overseen the program's transition to NCAA Division I FCS membership, with the program now fully eligible for the FCS playoffs beginning in 2025. Heading into this fall, senior cornerback Mo Seide was tabbed to the NEC All-Preseason team. Seide, along with senior defensive lineman Faisal Mass, junior linebacker Charles Battaglia and junior offensive lineman Joshua Troiano earned nods to the Phil Steele Preseason All-NEC Team.

In 2024, Seide was named to the All-NEC Second Team, as well as the All-New England Team by the New England Football Writers' Association. In addition, Battaglis garnered FCS Freshman All-America accolades.

The Skyhawks were the lone NEC member to knock off Conference Champion and NCAA FCS Playoff participant Duquesne in 2023 - doing so on the road in November. Nine Skyhawks have earned All-NEC honors over their first two seasons, with offensive lineman David Satkowski named the NEC's Scholar-Athlete of the Year two-straight years while also being named a finalist for the Doris Robinson FCS Scholar-Athlete Award. The program also received the NEC Team Sportsmanship Award in 2022.

Satkowski also made headlines for Stonehill by receiving an invitation to rookie mini-camp by the Chicago Bears before signing with the DC Defenders in the XFL. 47 Stonehill student-athletes have earned All-Conference honors over his eight seasons at the helm, including a record 14 in 2019. That season, Justin Felder became the program's first Harlon Hill Trophy Candidate and earned a spot on the American Football Coaches' All-America Team.

Gardner was selected to participate in the

2018 AFCA 35 Under 35 Coaches Leadership Institute, presented by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) and NCAA Leadership Development, during the 2018 AFCA Convention. Five Skyhawks earned NE10 Academic All-NE10 honors over his first three seasons, including quarterback Matt Foltz '18 who received the National Football Foundation Jack Grinold/Eastern Massachusetts Chapters' Jack Daly Award for

Academics, Citizenship and Football. Donovan Phannor '18 also earned a spot on the CSC Academic All-District I first team in 2017 and the football program received the NE10 Team Academic Achievement Award for having the highest team GPA among NE10 football programs two academic years.

within all of Division II since taking over as defensive coordinator.

16 Stonehill defensive players earned All-10 honors in Gardner's six seasons as defensive coordinator, with four also collecting All-Super Region 1 accolades and Jared Gaines, '13, and Brian Harrington, '15 earning All-America status. Harrington had a record-breaking season for the Skyhawks in 2013 and was a finalist for the inaugural Cliff Harris Award for the top small college defensive player in the country, while also earning the Joseph P. Zabalski Defensive Player of the Year Award from the Gridiron Club of Greater Boston.

Gardner helped guide the Skyhawks to a share of the NE10 regular season championship for the first time in program history in 2013 as the team posted its first winning season (8-3, 8-1 NE-10) since 1996.

Gardner initiated and continues to run the football program's social media market-

He finished his career with 147 tackles as a linebacker and defensive end and was part of a class that finished their careers with the most victories over a four year period in program history upon graduation. Gardner recently completed his Master's Degree in Athletic Administration from Endicott College in 2014.

Gardner, a native of Milford, New Jersey, currently resides in Bridgewater, with his wife, Stephanie, and son, Camden (8).

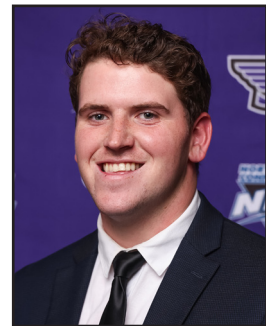

# W.B. MASON STADIUM

## TIMOTHY J. COUGHLIN '80 MEMORIAL FIELD AT W.B. MASON STADIUM



The College's multi-purpose athletic facility, W.B. Mason Stadium, was formally dedicated on September 10, 2005. The playing field at the stadium, Timothy J. Coughlin, '80 Memorial Field, was also dedicated on September 10th in memory of Tim Coughlin, a former football standout of Stonehill's Class of 1980, who had his life tragically cut short during the attack on the World Trade Center on September 11, 2001. W.B. Mason President and CEO Leo Meehan, who is also a Stonehill trustee and alumnus, announced that the Company and its alumni employees have committed \$1.5 million toward cost of the almost \$4 million project. The 2,400-seat W.B. Mason Stadium is a multi-purpose outdoor facility with a 400-meter, eight-lane track, FieldTurf (which was completely refinished in 2018), specialty areas for track and field events, and lighting for evening use. The facility is also home to field hockey and women's lacrosse. W.B. Mason Stadium served as host of the 2009 and 2016 NCAA Division II Field Hockey Championships, the 2010, 2014 and 2017 Northeast-10 Track & Field Championship and 2013 New England Track & Field Championships. The stadium served as host of the Northeast Conference Outdoor Track & Field Championships for the first time in 2025.
