Eva Brann was a faculty member at St. John's College in Annapolis, Maryland, for over sixty years. Among her numerous written works are over twenty books and more than two hundred lectures and addresses delivered at nearly one hundred institutions in thirty-four states and five foreign countries. She held degrees from Brooklyn College and Yale University and was a 2005 recipient of the National Humanities Medal.
