Francis Scott Key, Alumnus, Class of 1796

Panayiotis (Peter) Kanelos comes to St. John's with a distinguished record in higher education. After earning degrees from Northwestern University (BA), Boston University (MA), and the University of Chicago (PhD), he taught at Stanford University, the University of San Diego, and Loyola University Chicago. He served most recently as dean of Christ College, the Honors College of Valparaiso University. He founded the Cropper Center for Creative Writing at the University of San Diego and is a noted Shakespeare scholar, having served as the resident Shakespearean in the Old Globe MFA Program and the founding director of the Interdisciplinary Shakespeare Studies Program at Loyola University Chicago. An outspoken advocate for liberal education, President Kanelos is as passionate about teaching as he is about writing and scholarship.
