
The King William Players proudly present ?

Act I

Our play opens in Sicilia, where Polixenes, King of Bohemia, has been visiting his child-hood friend Leontes, the King of Sicilia. Leontes, convinced that Hermione has been false to him with Polixenes, and is pregnant by him, commands his trusted advisor, Camillo, to poison Polixenes. Camillo, instead warns Polixenes, and flees with him to Bohemia.

Act II

Leontes discovers the flight of Camillo and Polixenes and has Hermione committed to prison. He reveals that he has sent to Apollo's oracle at Delphi for a pronouncement on Hermione. Leonte's son falls ill. Paulina, a close friend of Hermione, visits her in prison and carrys the daughter Hermione has just given birth to, to Leontes. Leontes commands Antigonus, Paulina's husband, to abandon the child.

Act III

Messengers return from Delphi. The trial is convened, the oracle read, and Hermione cleared. Leontes, refusing to accept the oracle, orders the session to proceed. A servant enters and announces that the king's son is dead. Leontes repents his evil, but too late, Hermione, overcome with grief, dies in Paulina's arms. Antigonus, now on the stormy coast of Bohemia, where Hermione, in a dream has told his to leave the child with some letters revealing her birth, is attacked and eaten by a bear. The child is found by an old shepherd and his son who bear it off to reaise as their own.

Act IV

Sixteen years pass. Perdita, Leontes" lost daughter, is woodd by Florizel, Polixenes' son. Polisenes, aware of this. resolves to visit the sheperds' cottage in disguise with Camillo. They enter during the annual sheep-shearing feast. Autolycus, a rogue disguised as a peddler antertains the company. Polixenes reveals himself, and demands that Florizel and Perdita part. On Camillo's advice Florizel decides to flee with Perdita to Sicilia. Camillo leaves to inform Leontes of their flight. Autoclycus brings the old shepherd and his son unto the Prince's ship, with the secrets of Perdita's birth. All leave for Sicilia.

Act V

All meet at Leontes court. The secret of Perdita's birth is discovered. All, now reconciled, go to view a statue of Hermione in the keeping of Paulina. The statue is revealed, wondered at, then awakened by Paulina. Hermione embraces Leontes and blesses her daughter. Urged by Leontes Camillo and Paulina plan to marry. All leave to discuss their past sorrows and their present joy.
