Florida's Historic Coast remains an easy access drive destination. And, there is also great air service available via <u>Jacksonville International Airport</u> (JAX), approximately 50 minutes north of St. Augustine and 30 minutes from Ponte Vedra, and <u>Daytona Beach International Airport</u> (DAB) approximately 50 minutes to the south. Both airports are served by all major airline carriers.

New non-stop service with <u>Breeze Airways</u> between Jacksonville and eight cities across the U.S. recently started in May and June.

In addition, <u>Elite Airways</u> offers service between Newark Liberty Airport and Northeast Florida Regional Airport in St. Augustine. The nonstop jet flights operate with arrivals to St. Augustine on Monday and Thursday, and departures on Tuesday and Friday. Non-stop flights are also offered between Portland, Maine and Northeast Florida Regional Airport with arrivals to St. Augustine on Saturday and departures on Sunday.
