

## **DAY ONE**

**First Stop: St. Mary's County Welcome Center**. Freshen up at the Welcome Center housed in a historic building that was once part of the Charlotte Hall Military Academy. Start your visit at the adjacent Ye Coole Springs. Colonial governors in the 1700's credited the "Fountain of Healing Water" for wonderful cures.



**Second Stop:** Head south towards the **Potomac River** and visit **St. Clement's Island Museum** and discover Maryland's beginnings. Enjoy a guided tour of the museum which tells the story of Maryland's first landing. From Memorial Day through September, take a ride on the **Water Taxi** to the island and tour the Blackistone Lighthouse, a recreation of a 1800's structure, and view the enormous cross that commemorates the place where the colonists first landed.

**Third Stop:** Lunch. Travel to Historic St. Mary's City. Enjoy lunch "on your own" in the great hall at St. Mary's College or arrange for a lunch to suit your group at the historic site.

**Fourth Stop:** Spend the afternoon at Historic St. Mary's City. Tour the acclaimed St. John's Site Museum which encloses an actual archeological dig, and experience living history aboard the Maryland

## **DAY TWO**
