Biblical Insights for Christian Parenting (May 17, 2020)

To Our Families and Partners

Thank you for your interest in Grace Education! Raising the next generation in truth and wisdom is a high and precious calling. As a ministry of Grace Community Church, Grace Education provides spiritual shade for children through trusted programs and resources that are designed to equip students to know and love God. We are eager to help support you and your families.

Christians understand that God is the author and source of truth. God's Word is authoritative, inerrant, and profitable for teaching (2 Tim. 3:16). While the world may deny this reality, believers know that truth is of utmost importance. Because we care about what is true, we care about education as a means of helping many to know, love, and glorify God.

Sometimes education is mistakenly regarded as a neutral endeavor—one that simply shares data or facts without any moral component or life application. However, Christians know that education is never truly neutral because it is always built upon a conviction (or denial) about the source of truth. We believe that education is and should be distinctly Christian. Tragically, we see too many examples of worldly education where truth is twisted and learning is weaponized into indoctrination that rejects God. There is a continuous struggle and warfare underway to captivate the hearts and minds of students. For this reason, Grace Education is committed to advancing faithful educational options that revere God as Creator and the source of true knowledge and wisdom (Prov. 1:2–6). It is our prayerful desire that many will come to know God's Word and love Him deeply.

We are blessed with an ongoing heritage of faithful teaching. For more than five decades, Pastor John MacArthur showed how the church is the pillar and support of truth, and his verse-by-verse teaching encouraged countless believers to know the Bible (1 Tim. 3:15).

Pastor John entered the presence of our Lord on July 14, 2025, but his enduring vision and the church's care for Christian education continues. Through his book, *The War on Children*, and many sermons on parenting and education, Pastor John championed Christian

education clearly and boldly, calling out worldly assumptions and encouraging parents to think deeply and with discernment about education. Pastor John urged Christians to teach their children diligently so that even their children's children may someday know and love God, befitting the great call to parenting in Deuteronomy 6.

Grace Education continues a roadmap for ongoing equipping in truth. We hope that Christians will regard biblically-faithful education as an earthly priority with a truly eternal purpose. Our ministry sustains an enduring commitment to well-designed and thoughtfully delivered Christian education that strengthens families, trains students in truth, and raises up many to love Christ. Legacy Christian Academy



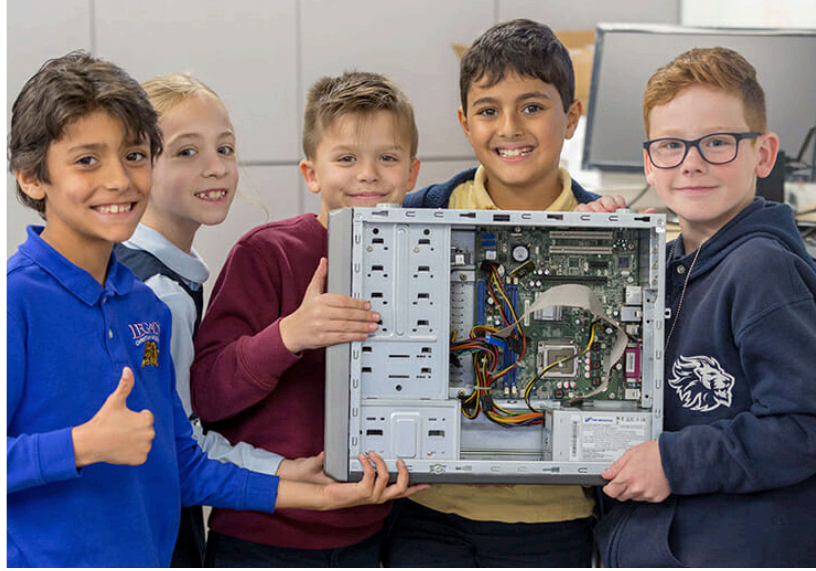

- Preparing sample K–12 Bible lessons for debut at ShepCon 2026 in anticipation of future sales
- Organizing online education options to support biblical language training for grade school students
- Outlining future strategies for K–12 academic curriculum for core subjects to be used in homeschool, hybrid, and site-based school settings
