

**Illustrator.** Grace Church has a full-time opening for an Illustrator. Job requirements include proficiency in Photoshop, strong character and background illustration skills, as well as the ability to adapt to the curriculum style guide. This position further requires an ability to collaborate with a team to produce consistency, the ability to manage a busy workload, and meet strict deadlines.

**Nursery Worker**. Grace Church currently has part-time openings, up to 15 hours per week, for a nursery worker on Sundays and throughout the week. Must be able to exhibit love to parents, children, staff and desire to serve through humility, patience and joy. Prior work experience in childcare is preferred and must be able to successfully pass a background check.
