Faith Promise Fruit

One of the most significant ways our church supports our missionaries is through Faith Promise. Our church family has so faithfully sent out and supported our missionaries "in a manner worthy of God," as those who are their "fellow workers for the truth" (3 John 6–8).

Our missionaries are dependent upon those of us who are able to partner with them to meet their ongoing financial needs. While they are generally able to meet expenses with this regular support, there are often unexpected ministry or personal needs that arise, and Faith Promise was created specifically to minister to these unanticipated needs.

Over this last year, through your generous Faith Promise giving, our church has been able to assist eight missionary families with extraordinary needs. This has allowed them to continue the work to which God has


called them, reaching even more people with the gospel. One such need arose earlier this year when Ruben Videira experienced an unexpected health issue that required medical treatment, and Faith Promise funds were used to assist his family as they continue to serve in Spain.

Faith Promise funds were also used this year for other unique missions endeavors, such as providing Bibles for Pakistani churches, sponsoring a ministerial trip to Ukraine, and assisting with a TMAI training center building repair. Additionally, your Faith Promise giving helps support the regional oversight responsibilities that some of our seasoned missionaries have. These extra funds enable them to provide more focused care and support to the other missionaries in their regions.

We thank you and praise God for your faithful giving to this critical program and ask that you keep all our missionary families in your prayers during the Christmas season.


