PROJECT FOOD PAK

he mission of Children's Hunger Fund (CHF) is to deliver hope to suffering children by equipping local churches for gospel-centered mercy ministry. CHF seeks to come alongside the local church by training and empowering churches in impoverished areas to serve those in need. Working through trusted church partners, CHF provides tangible resources that churches can use to become more effective, intentional, and gospelcentered in their mercy ministry. CHF partners with over 1,000 churches spanning the globe and reaching communities across 32 countries—and in Southern California alone, is partnering with over 100 local churches to serve thousands of families each year.

The main way CHF partners with local churches is through Project Food Pak, a program through which boxes of canned and non-perishable foods are provided for children whose families lack this basic necessity. Pastors and volunteers from local churches—including Grace Church—deliver these Food Paks directly

to the homes of those in need in their communities. Each child in the home receives their very own Food Pak, which serves as a simple but powerful gift and an expression of God's compassion for them.

When a Food Pak is delivered directly to a child by a pastor or volunteer from a local church, it becomes a tool for ministry. Food Paks open doors for churches to engage in a relationship with families in their neighborhoods, bringing opportunities for the gospel to be proclaimed.

Families receive much-needed food, but, more importantly, they have an opportunity to receive lasting hope though a relationship with Jesus Christ. The church is the vehicle to reach the lost, and Food Paks provide a platform for this critical ministry and evangelism to take place.

This was what happened in the case of David and Gloria and their two boys, Luca and Diego. After struggling to make the payments on the truck he used for his job, David lost his truck and his main



source of income. Although he and Gloria both worked, their income wasn't enough to meet their family's needs. Within just a few months of receiving Food Paks and being visited by members of the local church, David and Gloria got married, began attending church, were baptized, and started a Bible study. Luca and Diego's lives have been forever changed because of Christ, and the channel God used to work in their lives was Project Food Pak. They are growing up in a home that loves the Lord and that has a relationship with the local church, and their future is brighter because God has brought real change in the life of their family.

Over the next few weeks, Grace Church has the opportunity to participate in this unique ministry by filling Food Paks that will be delivered directly to children of families in need.

Here's how you can help...

- Pick up empty Food Pak boxes at distribution points around campus today or next Sunday, April 21.
- Fill them using the enclosed shopping list.
- Return them to the collection points around campus by Sunday, April 28.

CHF will then distribute these Food Paks through local gospel-centered churches, who will deliver them directly to children in need in their neighborhoods.

By filling a Food Pak, you are helping deliver hope to a suffering child in our community. Thank you for helping us extend mercy to these families.


