The Joy and Privilege of Serving our Church



race Community Church is not a place we merely attend; it is a body to which we belong. Scripture reminds us that "God has so composed the body...that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another" (1 Corinthians 12:24–25). Every believer has been gifted by God to serve, and when we neglect that calling, the body is weakened. Pastor John often said that the church flourishes not when it entertains spectators, but when it equips saints for the work of ministry.

The believer's service in the church, therefore, is not optional—it is the



natural outflow of genuine salvation. Paul exhorts us, "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them" (Ephesians 2:10). To be redeemed by Christ is to be set apart for His purposes. Serving in the church is one of the clearest demonstrations that our faith is real, alive, and working through love (Galatians 5:6).

To this end, our service strengthens assurance. When we labor in love for the sake of the gospel, we see evidence of God's transforming power within us. As Pastor John often emphasized, good works are certainly not the root of salvation, but they are always the fruit. A believer who resists service resists the very purpose for which he was redeemed. On the other hand, those who serve willingly find joy, fellowship, and spiritual growth.

Christ Himself declared that "the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many" (Mark 10:45). If our

Lord humbled Himself to wash the feet of His disciples (John 13:14–15), then we should joyfully embrace any tasks for the good of His body. Christ's example demonstrates that true greatness in the kingdom is measured not by how many serve us, but by how faithfully we serve others.

The New Testament church thrived because believers devoted themselves to this kind of service toward one another. They prayed, gave, taught, and cared sacrificially (Acts 2:42–47). That same model remains our standard today. A healthy church is not sustained by a few leaders carrying the entire load, but by every member functioning according to God's design. "As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God" (1 Peter 4:10).

When the body of Christ serves one another like this, we magnify Christ to a watching world. Jesus said, "By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one

another" (John 13:35). The church's testimony is weakened when believers sit idle, but it shines brightly when each member gladly gives of their time, talent, and treasure.

Service in the church is not a burden but a privilege. It is the pathway of Christian obedience, the evidence of grace, and the reflection of Christ's own heart. May we, then, heed the words of Romans 12:11: "not lagging behind in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord."

God has uniquely gifted each of us to serve, and there are ample opportunities here at Grace for you to make a difference.


