

◎ Museum Introduction

The Yang Ming Oceanic Culture & Art Museum is operated by the Yang Ming Marine Transport Culture Foundation and located on the west side of Keelung Port. The building was constructed in 1915 during the Japanese era and stands as a significant port landmark that has witnessed over a century of Keelung's maritime development. It was renovated and reopened in 2004 and continues to preserve Taiwan's port and ocean culture.
