Autodesk has a process for schools that want to sign Student Data Addendums with them. To begin the process, email <a href="mailto:student.dpa@autodesk.com">student.dpa@autodesk.com</a>. Autodesk has a Student Data Addendum on file that schools can sign.

Fusion is an industry grade CAD program used in PLTW Classrooms. Students will need an Autdesk Account to use Fusion. They can create an account on their own, or be enrolled via SSO by their IT team.
