

# City of Virginia Beach Community Organization Grant Review and Allocation Committee 2023-2024 Annual Report to City Council

### **Executive Summary**

During the fiscal year covering the period of July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024 the Community Organization Grant Review and Allocation Committee (COG Committee) volunteers and liaisons

- met five times during the fiscal year to review applications, conduct interviews, and determine grant awards for two funding rounds. Prior to FY24, COG only held one application round.
- An additional planning meeting was held that fell just outside of the FY 2023-24 window.

Our most significant accomplishments are detailed below.

#### **Mission Statement**

The Review and Allocation Committee (Community Organization Grant "COG") shall review applications, interview applicants, and allocate final COG funding to specific agencies each year following the adoption in the Operating Budget of a total COG funding amount.

Agencies requesting funding from the City annually shall submit applications each year in such form and manner as the City Manager may determine, and such applications are to be evaluated by the Review and Allocation Committee.

# Accomplishment of Goals and Objectives

Over the past fiscal year, the agency, though its appointed volunteers and its liaisons, worked on the following key matters in furtherance of its mission:

- 1. Reviewed 45 grant applications, including 17 applications from prior grant recipients and 28 from new organizations.
  - a. In FY24, the Committee reviewed \$2,690,536 in total grant requests, with a total budget of \$707,960.
  - b. Of those that applied, 26 organizations were eligible, and all 26 organizations were interviewed by the Committee. The total funding request among eligible organizations was \$1,122,633.
  - c. Of the organizations awarded a Community Organization Grant, the average grant award in FY24 was \$35,398, with the largest grant being \$75,000 and the smallest grant being \$5,000. The following table provides a summary of the FY24 Community Organization Grant awards, and their FY 23 award if applicable.

- 2. Tracked the use of funds administered to the organizations in relation to their goals and mission, through required reporting documentation.
  - a. Funded organizations expected to serve a total of 84,706 City of Virginia Beach residents but totaled 91,785.
  - b. Despite the shorter turnaround on funding and reporting as a result of the second application period, on average, organizations reached 98% of their target of City of Virginia Beach individuals served.
