

The M.E.O. Central Library houses Virginia Beach Public Library’s largest and most visited gallery. One of five gallery spaces in the system is located in the foyer near the side entrance, adjacent to the meeting rooms and auditorium. Both display walls are eight feet high, providing generous space for large exhibits and group displays.

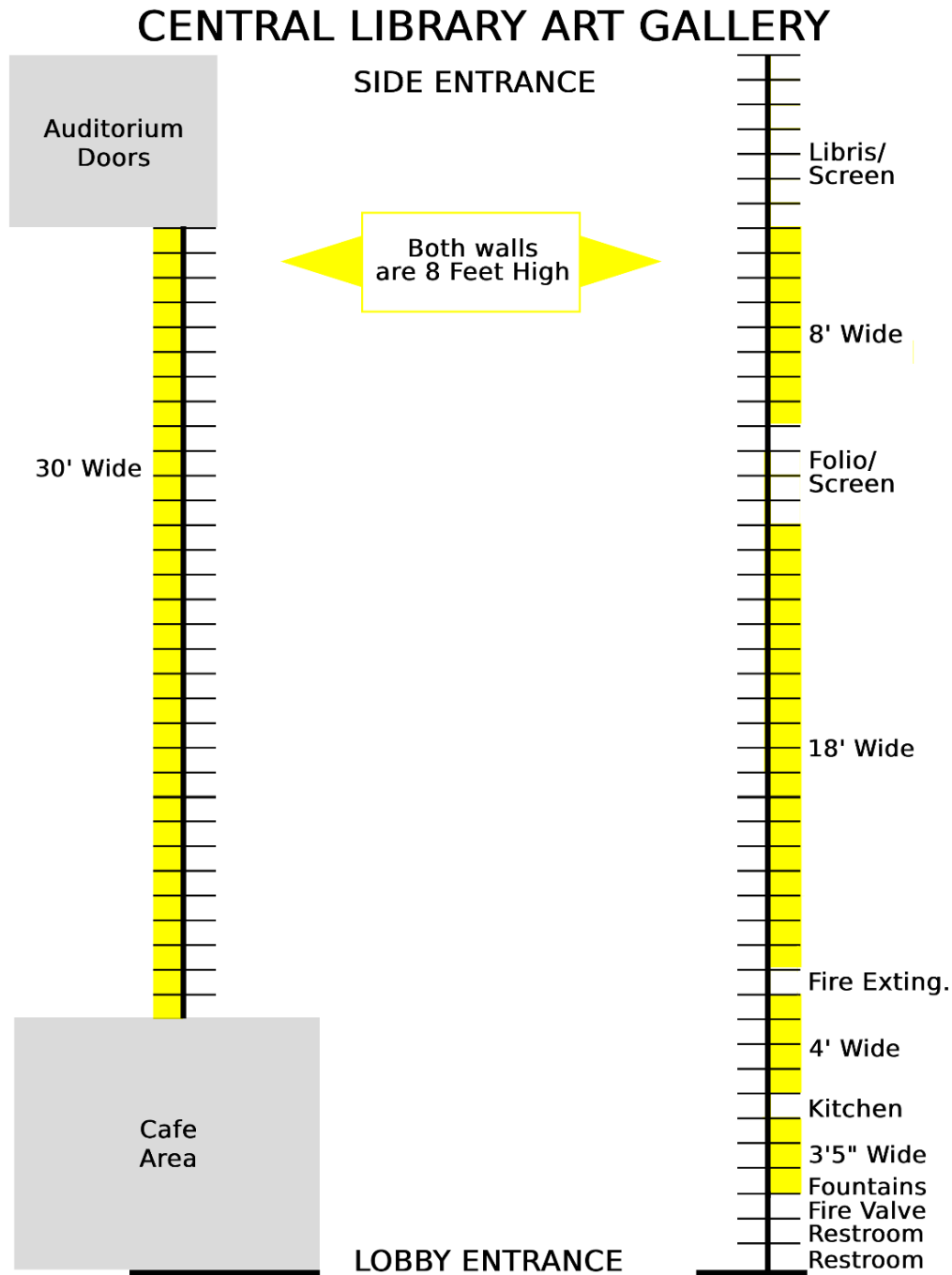


Image 1: Diagram of the Central Library gallery space.
