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# WETLANDS BOARD VIRGINIA BEACH, VIRGINIA PUBLIC HEARING MEETING MINUTES

The April 2023, Public Hearing Meeting for the Virginia Beach Wetlands Board was called to order by the Chair, Jason Barney, in the Council Chamber, 2401 Courthouse Drive, Virginia Beach, Virginia 23456 at 10:00 AM, April 17, 2023.

Chair Barney welcomed all, stated the responsible charge of the Wetlands Board, as delineated in the Virginia State Code and announced appeals are available through the Virginia Marine Resources Commission (VMRC) within ten (10) days of this Board's decision.

Approval expires two (2) years from the date it is granted. A permit is normally extended, but not an approval. Applicants are advised to obtain their permit within no more than thirty (30) days of their Hearing. Extensions must be requested before the expiration date.

Chair Barney acknowledged each applicant and/or agent for the applicant and administered the oath truth and honor.

The Chair stated that as required by law four (4) affirmative votes are required for an approval of a permit application. The Clerk announced that the Wetlands Minutes of March 20, 2023, was approved, as Amended. Chair Barney stated that Quorum was present.

The slide presentation for each application site was rendered by Ms. Heaven L. Manning.

- Any shellfish impacted by construction of the proposed improvements shall be removed from the structure(s), preserved in the water column, and returned/placed on the completed rip rap on site as applicable at a similar place in the water column.
- Revised plans shall be submitted to the Virginia Marine Resources Commission (VMRC) and ultimately approved by the Department of Planning and Community Development prior to the issuance of a building permit.

No Net Loss of wetlands on this project was achieved by the use of on-site compensation.

**PROJECT:** To construct a bulkhead and return wall involving wetlands.

**LOCATION:** 2709 Canal Road contiguous to Broad Bay

Upon motion by Ms. White, seconded by Ms. Crum, the application of **David A. Schrenk** was **APPROVED**, **AS MODIFIED**, **WITH THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS**:

- Any shellfish impacted by construction of the proposed improvements shall be removed from the structure(s), preserved in the water column, and returned/placed on the completed bulkhead at a similar place in the water column.
- Construction limits and associated land disturbance shall be limited to the area necessary to provide for a single point construction accessway as shown on the Site Access and Demolition Plan. The staging area, stockpiling of materials, and contractor parking area shall be noted on the revised plan, and all occur within the limits of construction.
- Wire reinforced thirty-six (36)-inch silt fence, for erosion and sedimentation control measures, shall be installed along the landward limits of the site access prior to any land disturbance and shall remain in place until such time as vegetative cover is established.
- 4. Permanent soil stabilization measures shall be applied to all disturbed / denuded area(s) outside of the limits of construction at the time of mobilization and within the limits of construction after the proposed improvements have been installed. All disturbed or denuded areas shall be stabilized in accordance with the Virginia Erosion and Sediment Control Law and Regulations.
- 5. Revised plans shall be submitted to the Virginia Marine Resources Commission (VMRC) and ultimately approved by the Department of Planning and Community Development prior to the issuance of a building permit.

No Net Loss of wetlands on this project was achieved by the payment of an in-lieu fee.
