- Creating open fires is prohibited. [City code section 12-5]
- Creating noise/sound that can be heard inside any adjoining residence is prohibited. [City code section 23-69 through 23-71]
- All trash shall be placed in automated refuse receptacle where provided. [City code sections 31-26, 31-27 and 31-28]
- Having more than three people per bedroom in the home after 11:00 PM is prohibited. [Zoning Ordinance Section 241.2]
- Events having greater than 50 people are prohibited unless a Special Events Permit is obtained prior to the occasion. [Zoning Ordinance Section 241.2]
