Our stormwater system works behind the scenes to collect rainwater, move it safely through the city, and help reduce flooding and pollution.

- Stay clear of ponds, ditches, pipes and drains.
- Don't play in flood water.
- Leave wildlife alone. Watch from a distance.

PONDS AND PIPES



- Ponds aren't for swimming or fishing. Banks are slippery and water depth changes quickly.
- Ponds can contain bacteria and algae that are harmful to people and pets.
- Never enter pipes; stay clear. Water flow can increase without warning.

DRAINS AND DITCHES



- Ditch banks may be steep. They can have hidden holes and slippery slopes.
- Drains can have strong suction. Keep hands and feet away, and never remove covers.

CANALS AND CULVERTS



- Never enter culverts; stay clear. Water levels and flow can increase quickly.
- Banks of canals can be slippery. Water can be deeper than it looks.
