ORDER OF WRIT OF SPECIAL ELECTION

IT APPEARING TO THE COURT:

- 1. That the Sheriff, elected for a term ending on December 31, 2025 resigned his office effective September 29, 2023; and
- 2. That the Code of Virginia § 24.2-228.1(A) provides that the governing body shall "petition the circuit court to issue a writ of election to fill the vacancy as set forth in Article 5 (§ 24.2-681 et seq.) of Chapter 6 [of Title 24.2 of Code of Virginia];" and
- 3. That the Code of Virginia § 24.2-228.1(A) further provides that "the governing body may request in its petition that the special election be held on the date of the next general election in November, and the court may order the special election to be held on that date."
- 4. Early voting for the November 2023 election has commenced. Therefore, the next ensuing general election to be held in November will be held on November 5, 2024; and
- 5. That on the 3rd day of October, 2023 the City Council of the City of Virginia Beach adopted a Resolution requesting the Court to order a special election for the purpose of filling the vacancy in the Office of Sheriff at the November 5, 2024 general election; NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:
- I. That the Petition for Entry of Order of Writ of Special Election and the attached Exhibits submitted by the City Council of the City of Virginia Beach, by counsel, in this matter are hereby filed; and

That the Court orders a special election to be held on November 5, 2024 for the II. purpose of electing a qualified voter to fill the vacancy in the Office of Sheriff for a term that commences in accordance with § 24.2-201 and ending on December 31, 2025; and

That the election shall be conducted and the ballots counted in the manner III. provided by law for other elections, and the results thereof shall be certified to the Court; and

That a copy of this Order shall serve as the Writ of Election. The Sheriff of the IV. City of Virginia Beach shall forthwith serve a certified copy of this Order upon the Secretary of the Electoral Board of the City of Virginia Beach and the general registrar of the City of Virginia Beach. The Sheriff shall make his returns to the Court that he has executed the same. The general registrar shall thereupon forthwith cause to be posted certified copies of this Order at not less than ten (10) public places in the City, or have notice of the election published once in a newspaper of general circulation in the City at least ten (10) days before the election; and

That the Clerk of the Court shall forthwith send a certified copy of this Order to V. the Virginia Board of Elections and to the City Attorney.
