There was no public comment

Mr. Piekarczyk made a motion to approve the minutes of the Committee's February 4, 2011 meeting, seconded by Mr. Schiel. The motion carried.

Mr. Diercks presented the Committee with a breakdown of website subscriber activity. Since the previous meeting, one public subscription had been renewed and and two private subscriptions renewed for a total of \$600. Mr. Diercks noted that there had been a net decline of five subscriptions since the last meeting.

Mr. Diercks advised the Committee that the 2010 flyover was complete. He had reviewed the planimetrics and accepted them on behalf of the County.

Ms. Redwitz and and Mr. Piekarczyk discussed a sign inventory project being undertaken by the Highway Department using one of the GIS Department's GPS units. The project is being undertaken in response to Federal guidelines regarding the reflectivity of signs.

Mr. Shoopman discussed changes to state real estate transaction reporting regulations regarding non-arm's length transactions. His office was beginning to compile data and has been in discussion with Mr. Diercks about mapping and analyzing these transactions.
